<b>Description</b> In init.php, eXtplorer uses the \$_SERVER['DOCUMENT_ROOT'] value to set the home_dir. When one has Joomla in an Alias directory of a VirtualHost, this leads to eXtplorer access the wrong (as in not the Joomla) directory. Changing to use the JPATH_ROOT value cures this.
